Notes: Cllr Mundy and Cllr Hobson shared some feedback from a meeting attended at WBC to discuss East Park Farm: The area, that WBC propose is handed to CPC, is much larger than previously considered. WBC did not have financial hard data, e.g. costs of current contracts, pavilion and pitch expenditure and income, available at the meeting. Committee favored the idea that the pavilion to be run as a sporting venue. Committee also liked the idea of there be a 'break out' point after five years. It was reported that WB Cllr Ray has asked WBC to cap the legal fees, if the hand over were to take place. It is expected that the financial data, including contracts, will be made available within the next 2 to 3 weeks. This will be further discussed at full council 17 November 2014.
