Cllr. Andersen reported that the Tree Survey is progressing slowly. There have been a few technical issues but some trees that had not been previously been mapped have been found. It was agreed to that this should be a standing item.

The PEH Chairman is to attend the Borough's Scrutiny Committee on 19th September and will bring various local issues to their attention including the overhanging plants on the roadside verge on the Old Bath Road between Twyford and Charvil, the overgrown area on the dual carriageway on the A4, and the state of the cycle track running between Charvil and Wargrave.
