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## Minutes of the Meeting of the Staffing Committee held on 23rd November 2020 at 8pm via Zoom

Present Claire Andersen (Chairman), Jim Gillett, Pat Sutlieff, Jane Hartley, Amanda Burton, Keith Hayward, Bernie Leicester, James Hines, and Miranda Parker **Absent** 80/20 **Open Forum** - There were no residents present. 81/20 **Declarations of Interest** – There were no declarations of interest 82/20 Notes of the Meeting held on 1st June 2020 - The notes were approved by the committee 83/20 Resolution to exclude members of the press and public due to the confidential Nature of the following agenda items - This resolution was approved To appointment of a Litter Picker and Village Warden – This was notes and James 84/20 Hines and Bernie Leicester were welcomed. 85/20 To consider how to ensure that the gates at East Park Farm are closed each night without being an excessive burden on one or two people – As James Hines is happy to open every morning, the gates are only a problem in the evenings. It was agreed that Bernie Leicester would set up a WhatsApp group for any Councillor volunteers, and if each person could put down the night or nights they can do, then hopefully the job will not fall on so few people as at present. This was to be tried for four weeks and Amanda Burton was to get the appropriate number of keys cut. James Hines has offered to cover Christmas Day. Clerk's note: most of the Council have volunteered so it is hoped this will work. To consider how the Pandemic has affected staff and to deal with any problems 86/20 that have arisen – The range of issues that have come up this year have been extremely hard to predict and advice has been patchy, so staff have been having to make decisions with little guidance at times. Holding meetings by Zoom is far from ideal, but the etiquette sheet produced by Cllr. Andersen is helpful. The increase in litter has also been hard to deal with, particularly as we were not fully staffed.
